Each pop-out drawer measures 2 x 4 x 5 1/4", overall cabinet size is 15 1/2 x 19 3/4 x 6 1/4". Designed to sit on a table or hang from a wall.

ScrapNCube 12 x 12 Six-Shelf Cubit with drawers

For storage that is functional as well as beautiful, this is the way to go. The basic wooden cube comes with five dividers; customize with drawers as you wish. Each drawer is 1 1/2" deep and can be used for stamps, ink pads, embossing powders and other small items. The drawers can be removed and double as handy trays.

index your **stamp images**

Know what you have and find it fast with a stamp image catalog.

Catalog your rubber stamp images Stamp each image and then categorized by theme, using a Rolodex, recipe file with index cards, 3-ring binder or tabbed notebook. Note the stamp name, manufacturer and any other necessary information.

Save time Find an image by flipping through your catalog and not your whole stash of stamps.

Avoid duplicate purchases When you go stamp shopping, bring your catalog along to see what stamps you already own.
